



How-to download eBooks to a Kindle or Kindle App

NOTE: If you want to listen to audiobooks and have a Kindle Fire (Fire OS 4.5.4 or above), use OverDrive Listen with the Silk browser instead. Borrow an audiobook from <https://coloradodc.overdrive.com> and select the "Listen now in browser" button. You can also use Libby (app by OverDrive) on an Apple or Android device to send Kindle books to your Kindle.

Here's what you'll need to get started:

1. A Delta County Library card.
2. A Kindle device or Kindle app installed on your smartphone or tablet.
3. An active wi-fi connection.

Here's what you'll need to do:

1. Go to <https://coloradodc.overdrive.com/> using your computer's web browser (if using a Kindle Fire or HD you can use the device's web browser) and click **Already have a card? Sign in**.
2. On the next screen, choose 'Delta County Libraries' from the drop-down list, enter your library card number (no spaces), and **Sign in**.
3. Search for a book you'd like to read. You can click on the '**Kindle Books**' collection at the top or search by keyword, author, or subject from the search box. Advanced Search will give even more options. You can also browse Subjects or Collections.
4. Once you find a book to read and it's 'Available', select **Borrow**. Choose your checkout period (7, 14, or 21 days) and click **Borrow** again. *If it says **Place a Hold**, it means all copies are checked out. You can place an item on hold and be notified when it is available.*
5. Select **Read now with Kindle** (do not click on 'Download EPUB'). Amazon.com will open. Sign in to your account if you're not already.
6. If you have more than one Kindle device, you will need to select a device. Once your desired device is selected, click **Get Library Book**.
7. If your Kindle is wi-fi enabled, or you are sending the eBook to a device with the Kindle app, the book will automatically be sent to your device. You're now ready to read your Kindle eBook!
8. If your Kindle is not wi-fi enabled:
 - a. Go to "Content and Devices" page on Amazon's website and select **Books**.
 - b. Find the title in the 'Content' list, then select the **More actions** button.
 - c. If available, select **Download & transfer via USB** in the list.
 - d. Follow Amazon's prompts to complete the transfer.

To return a Kindle eBook early:

1. From the **Accounts and Lists** menu in Amazon (Account Settings on mobile), go to **Content and Devices**.
2. Next to the item you wish to return click on the **Return this book** button. Confirm by clicking on **Return this book**.
3. The title will remain on your Kindle until you re-sync the Kindle with your Amazon account.
